Brandão: We had the incredible opportunity to be part of the FilmEU Pilot projects.

Brandão (voiceover): The following five principles are core to the success of the pedagogical framework:

- 1. Diversity and Inclusion
- 2. Equality and Equity
- 3. Mobility
- 4. Sustainability
- 5. Technological Mediation



[INFOGRAPHIC - Challenge-Based Learning]

Brandão (voiceover): Challenge-Based Learning in arts education is about exploring real-world problems as an integral part of the creative process. Students critically evaluate the social impact and implications of their creative work, actively working to positively transform society.

[INFOGRAPHIC - Hybrid Learning]

Brandão (voiceover): Hybrid learning, and blended learning offer genuine connections and the building of a strong online and offline student community. It also provides the flexibility of distance learning and reduces barriers to education through asynchronous learning options.

[INFOGRAPHIC - Student-Centered Approaches]

Brandão (voiceover): Student-centered approaches recognize students as co-creators in their own education. Individual needs and collective identities are taken into account to create a personalized learning experience.

[INFOGRAPHIC - Annual Challenge Topic]

Brandão (voiceover): Once an Annual Challenge Topic is defined, modules and activities are designed and implemented to support it.

Daniela: In 2021 the theme was "Gender, Sexuality and Censorship". In 2022 the the theme was "Sustainability and art" it was called film as art.

Brandão (voiceover): As part of the project, we defined groups and countries for shooting days. I stayed in Portugal, and it was my responsibility to prepare everything for the production.

[INFOGRAPHIC - Consortium of European Universities]

Brandão (voiceover): Our project was a collaboration of students and staff from various cultural backgrounds. FilmEU's consortium includes four countries: Portugal, Belgium, Estonia, and Ireland, represented by four schools: Lusófona University, LUCA School of Arts, Tallinn University, and IADT. In the close future, we'll be 8 school across Europe.

Brandão: We had several online meetings to plan different aspects of our project, with the invaluable guidance of our tutor.

Brandão (voiceover): Using challenge-based learning, we creatively addressed realworld issues in our film.

[INFOGRAPHIC - Hybrid Learning]

Brandão (voiceover): Hybrid learning allowed us to connect both online and offline, making it a great experience for us. We worked together as a student-centered team, learning and creating collaboratively.

Daniela: We were seven students from each country. The first semester we developed 3 pilot's around the theme Gender, Sexuality and Censorship. Then we met in January in Lisbon to decide which pilot's would be filmed, build the teams and start to work. After some weeks working online we made our travels and filmed our pilot's. I went to Belgium, Genk and I was Production Designer and Transmedia. The exhibition was in Ireland in June of 2022.

Brandão: When my colleagues arrived, we went to see the shooting locations. Our short film was a unique blend of animation with Playmobil characters and real footage. We even had to build mini furniture and a small replica house for our animation, which took us a day of hard work.
